From the Pastor

As I write this article I am making the final preparation for a funeral. I can't help but think what a person would say if the person wasn't a Christion. When all is said and done what could a person say if they did not know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior?

One of the readings comes from Romans 8, "what, then shall we say in response to this?" The truth is, without Jesus Christ, there is nothing to give the mourner hope. There is nothing to share with whoever might be at the funeral.

What do you do when there is no hope to be shared? I believe that the usual answer is to avoid the question A Christian funeral is replaced by focusing on the life now ended. The message tends to suggest an alternative to Christ's death and resurrection. Mention is sometimes made of human good works or the avoidance of evil on the part of the deceased. I can't picture anyone faced with a message without hope.

In an hour I will be standing in the pulpit again. Thank God I am able to share the hope that we have—Because Jesus lives we shall live also.


