# From the Pastor

Have you ever wondered how the service that you see on the wall is developed? I asked Devin Biggs to give us a summary. Here is his response.

We added the PowerPoint to St. Mark in 2019. It got some use before it went dark for a short time. I volunteered to build the PowerPoint and the

rest is history. As we've grown with it as a Congregation, Terri, Sally, Pastor Miller, and myself built a routine for assembling the PowerPoint.

Early in the week Terri will email me the first draft of the bulletin. Sally will then check for any corrections. Terri, or Sally when appropriate, will send any corrections

my way. I then take the bulletin, corrections, and start putting it into PowerPoint form with my computer at home. I have separate files for No Communion, Communion, and special services like Christmas and Easter for example. Most of the assembling is copy and paste. It typically takes me 30-45 minutes to put it together. I use 2 computer screens. One for PowerPoint. One for the bulletin. Makes it easier to organize.

Anything outside of the copy and paste procedure boils down to the corrections, or even a change in the pictures on the PowerPoint. Andy Wyss made all the "Welcome" and "Depart" images you see every week. Sometimes I have to build multiple PowerPoints in a week if there are special services.

The other trick is formatting. Those in the Congregation, and even viewing at home, need to be able to read the PowerPoint. I make sure it doesn't get any smaller than 50 point font.

Once the PowerPoint is put together, I email it to myself and the church email. I download the PowerPoint to the projector computer. I title it by the appropriate day and service. I then check the presentation with the bulletin by the computer to make sure there are no errors. I also fire up the projector at the same time to make sure everything is working and fits properly.

Once that's done, it's all ready for our wonderful volunteers to run on Thursday, Sunday, or when we have a special service. By the way, we're always looking for volunteers to run the PowerPoint in church! Get in touch with myself and/or Terri in the office if you're interested! It's easy to learn!

#### **ST. MARK QUILTERS**


